What is a Carers Assessment?

It is an opportunity to talk about how your caring role affects you and to see if you qualify for practical support in your caring role. It is not a test of your caring abilities!

The assessment is carried out by an experienced worker from Leeds City Council or a Social Worker who is already involved with you and the person you care for.

You may be eligible for help if the care you provide is regular and the person you care for couldn't manage without your help.

What support could you get?

- Practical help with the house or the garden, either one off or regularly
- Gym membership or access to other wellbeing support
- Equipment to keep in touch with family or friends
- Something else which could support you personally in your caring role

Request an assessment
