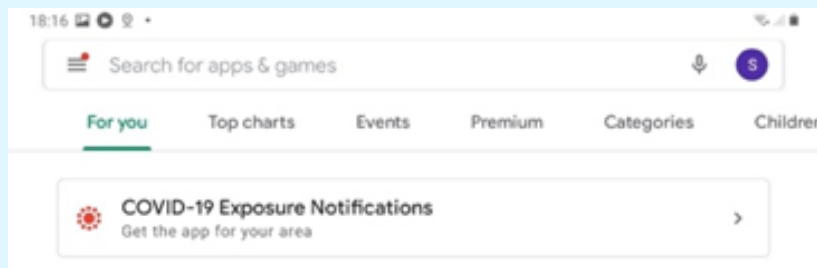

Unlock your device.

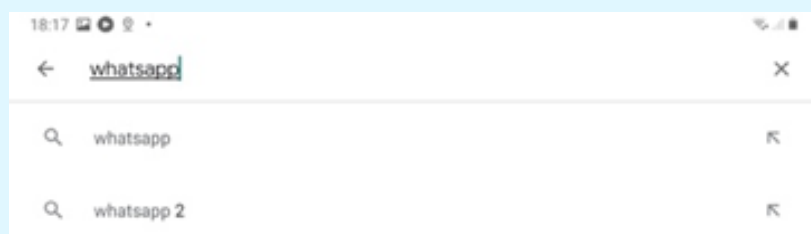
Open the 'Google Playstore' icon on your device. This is the logo:



Tap the search bar at the top of the screen.

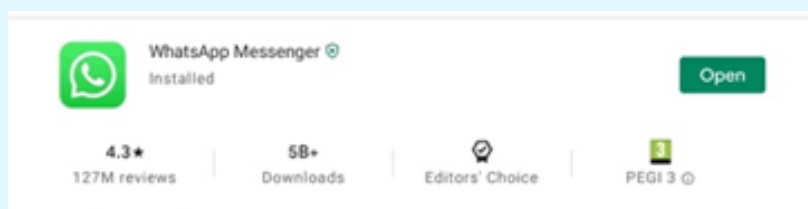
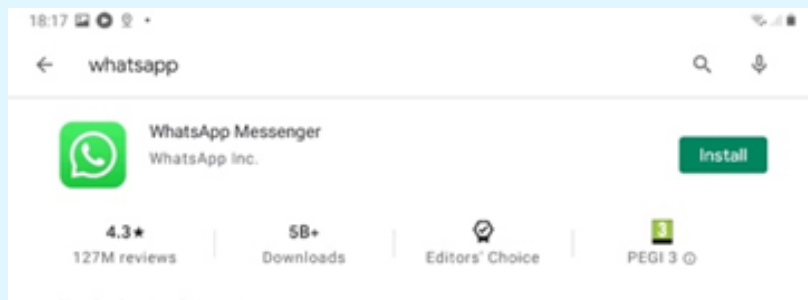


This will bring up the keyboard on your device - type in the app you wish to download (i.e. WhatsApp) and tap the spy glass on your keyboard to search.





Once the app is found, tap the 'Install' button - your device will now install the app. You will know the app has downloaded as the 'Install' button will now say 'Open'.



Your app will now appear in your applications - this means you have now successfully downloaded an app!
