Text messages allow us to quickly communicate with contacts on our phone. All you need is a mobile number a data plan, and the number of the person you wish to send the text to.

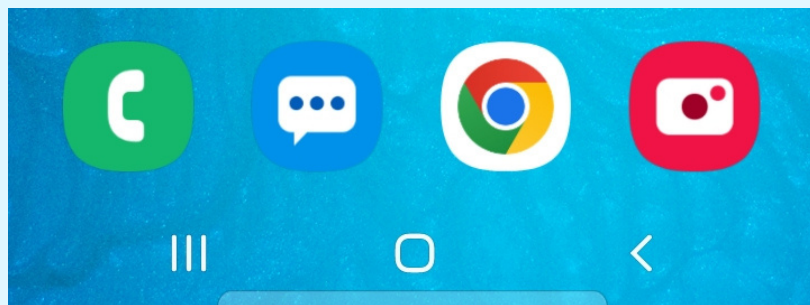

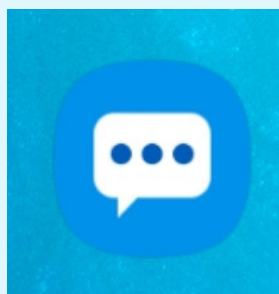

Unlock your device.

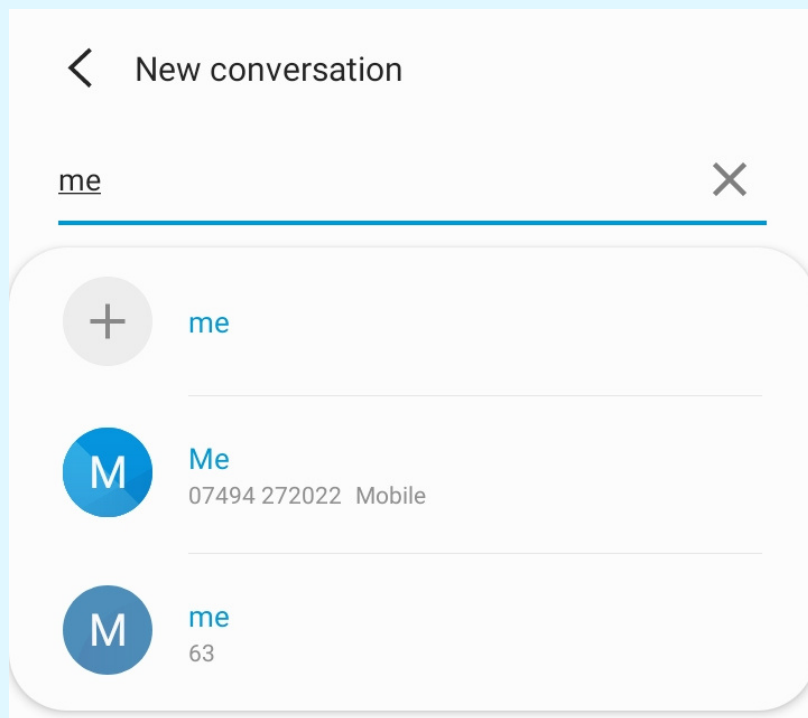
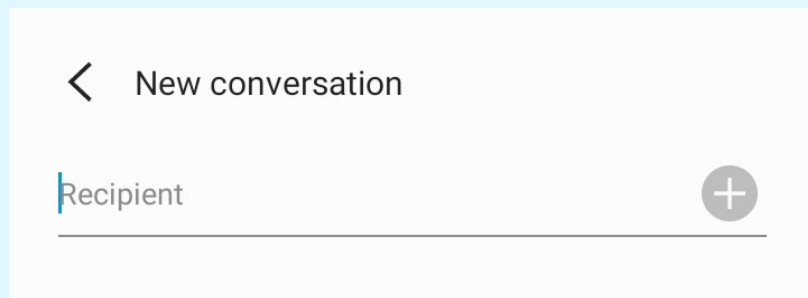
Tap the 'Messages' icon. It usually looks like a speech bubble and appears on your home screen.



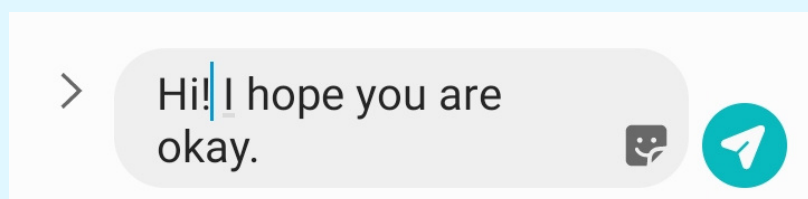
Tap the message bubble to compose a new text.



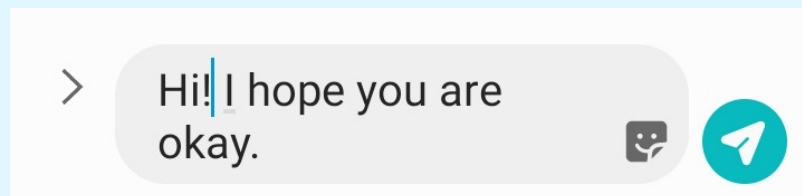
Type the name or number of the recipient into the 'Recipient' box.
