Carers Leeds offers free support and information to unpaid carers across Leeds.

We can help carers with:

- One to one support - telephone or face to face
- Support groups – a chance to meet other carers
- Training
- Social activities
- Information about getting a break from caring
- Help to get a Carers Assessment
- Help to get online or use devices such as computers, iPads and mobile phones
- Help to check that you and the person you care for are receiving the right benefits

Recovery Hub Support

Carers Leeds has workers who specifically work in Recovery Hubs.

We offer:

- Support and someone to talk to if you are feeling worried
- Information about funding for care homes or other packages of care
- Assistance to find a care home or package of care for the person you care for
- Help to make sure your views are considered in decisions about the person you care for being discharged
